2. Limit one entry per student per category.
3. All entries must be submitted electronically, following uploading instructions (refer to Directions for Naming and Submitting Entries ONLINE document). Mailed entries will not be accepted.
4. The following information will be needed when you fill out the ONLINE ENTRY/PERMISSION FORM. Gather it ahead of time so you can easily complete this form in a single session. Here is the link to the form (<http://bit.ly/1pKfbP5>).
 - Student's name, age and grade
 - School name, address, phone number and district
 - Name, cell phone number & email address of the nominator (teacher/adult) who approved submission
5. Submissions **WITHOUT** corresponding permission forms will not be accepted.
6. All submissions become the property of Kidsbridge.
7. Winners will be announced by the end of May. Winners or a representative are strongly encouraged to be present at the Kidsbridge **Walk2Stop Bullying** on Saturday, June 18 (9:00 a.m. to noon) to participate in an awards ceremony and to accept a certificate and other awards.
