

Diversity Fold-over Game

This game is best for 3 or more players, but two people can play it.

- 1. Prepare the paper and get comfortable
 - Everyone should have a blank sheet of paper (lined paper is fine).
 - Fold the paper into thirds. Mark neck and leg lines so that it looks like this:


- Sit where you can draw privately. No one should see the full pictures until they are all filled in!
- Important: It does not matter if you do not think you are good at drawing. These pictures are supposed to come out funny and people who do not draw very often make the funniest pictures. You can also use words to help other people in the game understand your picture.
- 2. Draw the body parts
 - Draw a picture of your own head in the top third. Use the neck lines to know where the head should be.
 - Fold over the head and pass the paper to the next person. DO NOT LOOK AT THE HEAD THAT IS FOLDED OVER!
 - Draw a body starting from the neck lines. Make the body show an activity that you enjoy. The body joins to the top of the leg lines.
 - Fold over again and pass the paper to the next person.
 DO NOT LOOK AT THE HEAD AND BODY THAT ARE FOLDED OVER!
 - Finally, draw legs to show another thing about you. It could be another activity, a pet, favorite clothes, etc.
