

Sensory Outside Scavenger Hunt



You and your family can go on this hunt in the rain or in the sunshine. There's only one item that is just for a rainy day. At the end of the Hunt, check with each other to see if everyone found that item.

Directions

- 1. Each person gets a copy of the list and a pencil
- 2. All check off each item on their list when they find it. If they want to, they can write down or draw what the item is
- 3. After most of the people on the hunt have found all or almost all the items on the list, they share their discoveries. Usually, some people in your family will finish searching quickly. Others will take a longer time. Not getting upset and saying something unkind to a family member who
 - is faster or slower than you takes self-control. You may have to take a deep breath and/or put your hand over your mouth so that you don't tell a family member, "Hurry-up" or "Don't go so fast."
- 4. How many of the people on your scavenger figured out the one rain-only item?
